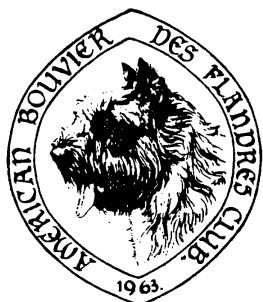

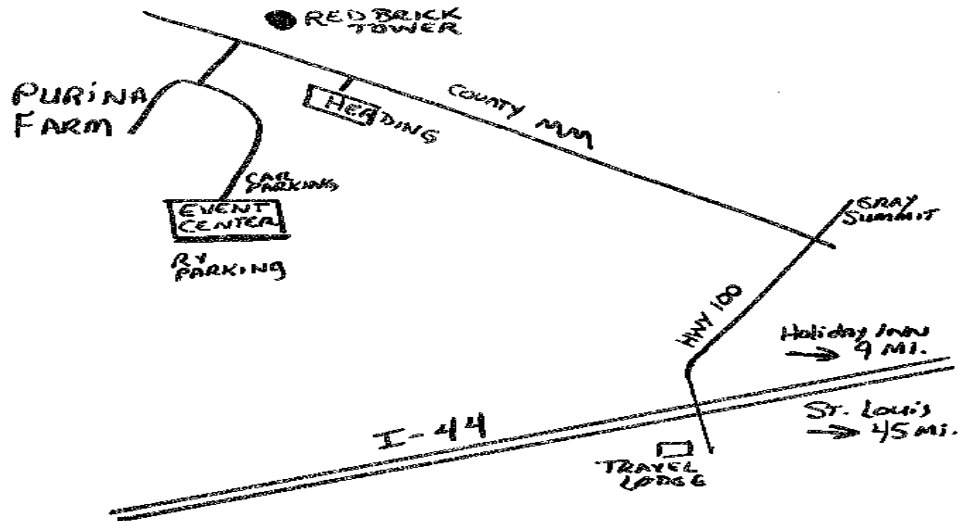

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

I-44 35 miles WSW from St. Louis, MO. I-44 to exit 253, Hwy 100. Turn Right onto Hwy 100 for .4 miles. Turn Left onto MM for 1.2 miles. Turn Left onto Checkerboard Loop into Purina Farms. The show site is past the farm and the education center in the far left section of the property.



HOTELS

Attendees & Guest Behavior: There occasionally arises a situation where an attendee's behavior in the hotel or at an event site becomes a cause for an unhappy situation that compels the club to take action in order to maintain good relations with the hotels and/or the show site. Complaints will be investigated & the parties involved will be asked to comply with corrective actions required immediately. Each dog owner, guest or registrant is expected to cooperate, cease & desist offensive actions, settle damage claims on the spot & provide insurance or other pertinent information as required or requested. Infractions of any rule or failure to comply may be cause for an official event committee hearing & possible suspension of AKC privileges. It is no fun for anyone having to deal with misconduct, but we will, if necessary, so please don't force this issue.

Building will be available 6AM to 9PM.

Handicapped accessible.

Free parking and admission.

Rabies and other vaccinations are required to be up to date.

NO SMOKING IN THE BUILDINGS.

No alcoholic beverages allowed on the grounds.

Grooming and crating allowed in designated areas only. Reserved grooming (first-come basis) will be in the Great Hall where the rings are. Overflow grooming will be in the Gateway Hall – across the lobby from the Great Hall.

Turn off cell phones and pagers before entering the ring.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEMSELVES AND THEIR DOGS. Please use designated areas.

RV parking must be arranged through the RV parking Committee Chairman. Do not contact Purina Farms directly or you will be placed in the end spot when you arrive.

No dogs (except service dogs) are allowed in the Checkerboard Café, on the second floor of the Event Center or in any human restroom or bathing facility.

No unentered dogs allowed on the premises.

No vehicles are allowed to drive in either hall, or on sidewalks.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE (continued)

Keep all fire lanes open at all times.

15 minute parking in any loading area.

No swimming in any pond on the property.

Trespassing on Land O' Lakes/Longview Animal Nutrition Center property is forbidden.

Exhibitors accept personal liability with respect to any claim made for any damage or injury caused by their dog/s or their children or dogs in their possession.

No selling of puppies or dogs on the premises.

Purina Event Center staff reserves the right to refuse entry to any person/party or animal and retains the right to remove any person or persons and/or any animal from the premises in order to ensure the safety of any and all visitors and dogs to the Purina Event Center. Exhibitors indemnify Purina, the affiliated person/s or businesses conducting the show or trail against any and all claims that may be leveled against them, jointly or severally, in respect to any damage, injury or loss to persons, pets and/or property.

All dogs are required to be on leash at all times, except when crated or as required to be judged.

If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. No refund of entry fee will be made in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The show-giving club has no obligation for locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. The show giving club, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

Novice Junior Class: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places awards, with competition, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places awards, with competition, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

Novice Senior Class: For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places awards, with competition, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

Open Junior Class: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places awards, with competition, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

Open Intermediate Class: For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places awards, with competition, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

Open Senior Class: For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places awards, with competition, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

(Novice Classes not offered at these events.)

- Dogs entered in the Amateur Owner Handler Class must be at least 6 months of age, and not a Champion of Record. Dogs must be handled by the owner. Exhibitors cannot be, or have been a professional handler, an AKC conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler, or be an immediate family member of a professional handler.
- Awards of Merit for ABdFC will be selected after the Best of Breed competition, at the discretion of the judge. The number of Awards of Merit will be 10% of the total entry for Best of Breed competition, up to a maximum of eight (8) awards. Grand Champion Select Dog and Bitch are included in the Award of Merit Selection. The remaining Award of Merit selection will be designated in no particular order and in any quantity per gender, subject to the overall limit. Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed are excluded from Award of Merit selection.
- Awards of Merit for NIBdFC will be selected after the Best of Breed competition, at the discretion of the judge. The number of Awards of Merit combined with Grand Champion Select Dog and Bitch will be up to 10% of the total entry for Best of Breed competition. The Award of Merit selection will be designated in no particular order and in any quantity per gender. Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Grand Champion Select Dog and Bitch are excluded from Award of Merit selection.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES for Single Dog entries

Veteran Dog/Bitch (ABdFC and NIBdFC) – For dogs/bitches 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. Neutered dogs or spayed bitches may compete in veteran classes at independent specialties. The winner of the class is eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Working Dog/Bitch (ABdFC and NIBdFC) – Dogs/bitches must be at least 6 months of age on the day of the show, hold an AKC performance title (Obedience, tracking, herding, agility, rally). Champions may compete in this class. Dogs must not be spayed or neutered. The winner of this class is eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Altered Dog/Bitch (ABdFC Only) – Dogs/bitches must be over 6 months of age and be spayed or neutered. Champions may be shown in this class. The winners of these classes will compete for a separate Best of Breed-Altered.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES for Multiple Dog entries

ABdFC ONLY

As the judge's decision in these classes are judged on the merits of more than one dog, the winner is not eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Stud Dog/Brood Bitch – For a Stud Dog/Brood Bitch and two of their get. It is not necessary that the various get of the Stud Dog have the same owners. Get must be entered in a regular class, and do not have to be named at the time of entry. Class to be judged on the merits of the get. Entry fee for the unit is \$30 if the stud dog/brood bitch is not entered in another regular class, and \$20 if it is an additional class for the stud dog/brood bitch. Stud dog/brood bitch is shown in the ring with the get and examined for conditions that would require disqualification or excusal. Entry to be judged on the merits of the get.

Brace – For two dogs, regardless of sex, which are similar in appearance, performing in unison, presented by a maximum of two handlers. Each dog must also be entered in a regular class, or entered in Brace class only. Entry fee is \$20 for the unit. Both dogs need to be identified at the time of entry in the space for Additional Class.

Team – For four dogs which are similar in appearance, performing in unison, presented by a maximum of four handlers. Each dog must also be entered in a regular class, or entered in Team Class only. Entry fee is \$20 for the unit. All dogs need to be identified at the time of entry in the space for Additional Class.

Maturity – A class to be judged based on the consistency of type in three generations of dogs, regardless of sex. At least one of the entries must be entered in a regular class with Maturity Class as an additional class. A bitch or dog must be shown with a son or daughter and a grandson or granddaughter. The grandson/granddaughter need not be out of the son/daughter being shown. Only one dog per generation shown oldest to youngest. All dogs must be identified at the time of entry in the space for Additional Class.

NOTE: If the same owner enters more than one brace, team, or maturity, each entry should be designated as Brace 1, Brace 2, etc.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES for Multiple Dog entries

NIBdFC ONLY

As the judge's decision in these classes are judged on the merits of more than one dog, the winner is not eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Breeders Class – Three or more dogs entered as one unit. Dogs must be bred by at least one breeder in common, that breeder to carry the armband number and be the handler of the first entry in the class. Dogs must be out of at least 2 different litters. Dogs must be identified at the time of entry in the space for Additional Class

No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.
