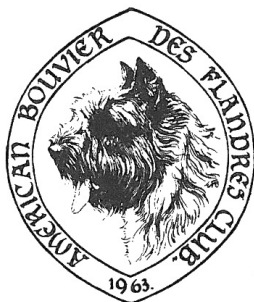

The Lancaster Host Resort & Conference Center is easy to find. It is located on State Highway 30 just east of Lancaster.

The resort is just a few minutes south of Interstate 76. Take the Route 222 Exit, follow Route 222 to Route 30 and follow Route 30 East.

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

From Philadelphia: Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-76) West to Exit 21. Route 222 South to Route 30 East. The hotel will be on the right hand side approximately five miles ahead on Route 30.

From Philadelphia Airport: I-95 South to Route 322 West. Then Take Route 322 North until you reach Route 1. Take Route 1 South to Route 41. Then take Route 41 North to Route 30. The hotel will be on your left.

From Baltimore: Take I-83 North to Route 30 East. The hotel is located on the right hand side eight miles ahead on Route 30.

From Harrisburg: Take Route 283 East to Route 30. The hotel is located on the right hand side of Route 30. It is approximately 30 miles from Harrisburg.

From Pittsburgh: Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-76) East to Route 222 South to Route 30. The hotel will be on the right hand side approximately five miles ahead on Route 30 East.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 2:00 PM on Monday, October 17, 2016. Dogs may remain at Show Site until 10:00 PM each day. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best of Breed, Friday, October 21, 2016.

During the normal activities of the specialty, people and dogs will move about the Lancaster Host. Dogs are to be leashed at all times.

Dogs MAY NOT be left in the Expo center overnight. There is no smoking in the Expo Center.

Please make reservations by phone only. Mention the American Bouvier des Flandres Specialty for the discounted room rate. The rate per night is 109.00. This includes a full hot breakfast buffet for all room occupants. Complimentary wifi is available in hotel rooms and common areas. Wifi is not available in the Expo Center.

Check in time is after 4:00 PM; Check out time is 11:00 A.M.

Resort Pet Policy:

1. Maximum of four (4) crated animals per room. All will be same breed or of similar size.
2. Non-refundable pet charge of \$30.00 per room.
3. Pets must be crated at all times when they are alone in the room.
4. Bedspreads will be removed.
5. Pets are not permitted in suites.
6. Hotel has arranged a designated pet area for dogs to relieve themselves. It is the responsibility of the dog owners/guardian to clean up after their animals. Pets are not allowed on the golf course or in the outdoor pool courtyard.
7. Animals are not allowed in the Main Lobby (other than entering or leaving the assigned meeting/exhibit space), in restaurants or other common areas.
8. Hotels linens/towels may not be used to wash pets.

Hotel Rules: Be considerate. "Clean up after your dogs". There will be bags available for proper disposal of dogs' feces. There will be designated areas for you to ex your dogs. No dogs allowed on the Golf Course and NO dog bathing or grooming in Hotel Rooms." (We are continually losing facilities to host our dog shows. This is due to inconsiderate and irresponsible dog owners). Please be responsible!

There will be a dog bathing station near the grooming area. Bring your own towels and shampoo.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the show Superintendent to be advised at once. The Show Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

THE CLUB RESERVES the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. **ALL TROPHIES AND PRIZES** must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD OR AN ATTENDEE'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor or attendee. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors and attendees will exercise control and restraint over their children on the days of the show.

ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THESE DOG SHOWS hereby waive any claim for damages against the American Bouvier des Flandres Club, Inc. its members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Effective May 1, 2006 an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
