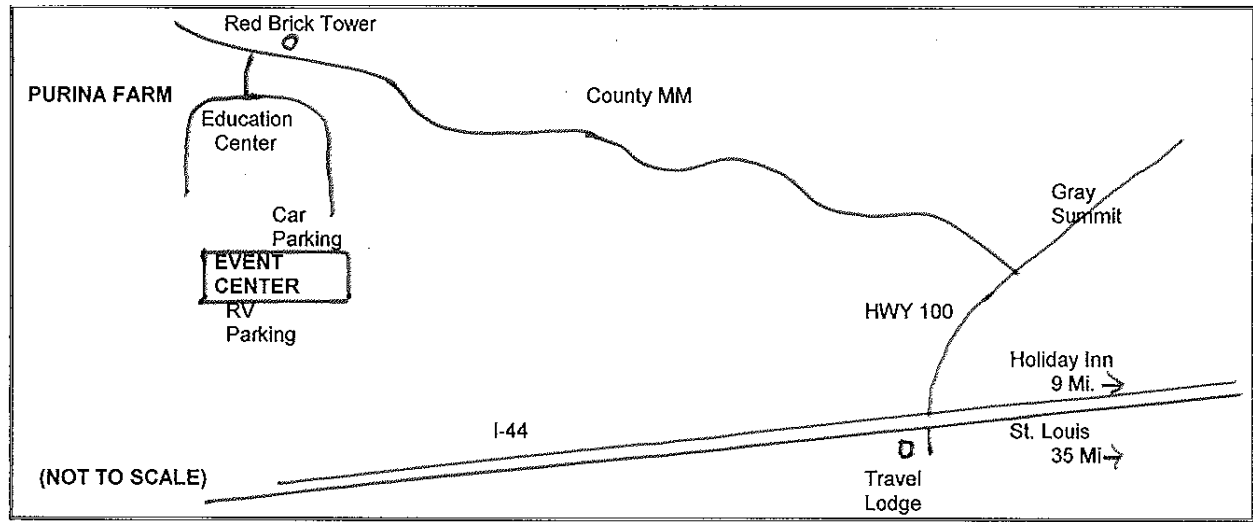

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

From Lambert-Saint Louis International Airport: I-70W / I-270S / I-44W.

I-44 35 miles WSW from St. Louis, MO. I-44 to exit 253 Hwy 100. Turn right(N) on to Highway 100 for 1/2 mile. Turn left onto MM for 1 mile. MM is a very winding road. Large vehicles - use care. Turn left onto Checkerboard Loop into Purina Farms. Go past the guardhouse, left around the Activity Center, then right to the far left corner of the property.

Dogs need to be present only at time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Buildings will not be opened until after 5:00 pm on Sunday, October 7 for exhibitors.

Grooming spaces may not be marked and available until after 3:00.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

We are sharing the site with the Giant Schnauzer Club of America and its affiliates. Please be courteous.

Clean up your grooming area, pick up after your dogs and keep the show and hotel properties clean. We want to be good guests and be able to use these facilities in future years.

Dogs may NOT be left in the building overnight.

All dogs and equipment must be out of the building by 8:00 PM Saturday October 13.

Food and beverages are available on-site in the Checkerboard Café.

Free parking and admission.

Rabies and other vaccinations are required to be up to date.

NO SMOKING IN THE BUILDINGS

No outside food or beverages allowed. Violators will be reported to AKC.

No alcoholic beverages allowed on the grounds.

Grooming and crating allowed in designated areas only. Reserved grooming (first-come basis) will be in the Great Hall. Overflow grooming will be in the Gateway Hall – across the lobby from the Great Hall.

Saturday Judging will be in the Gateway Hall.

No expenses in the front of the Event Center. Expenses on grass should not have matting (to prevent damage to grass).

All persons and animals on the show grounds at any time while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, video tape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.

Turn off all cell phones and pagers before entering the ring.

Please use designated areas for exercising your dogs.

RV PARKING MUST BE ARRANGED THROUGH THE RV PARKING COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.

Reserved RV parking will be available after 12:00 pm on Sunday, October 7.

No dogs (except service dogs) are allowed in the Checkerboard Café, on the second floor of the event center or in any human restroom or bathing facility.

No unentered dogs allowed on the premises.

No vehicles are allowed to drive in either hall, or on sidewalks.

Keep fire lanes open at all times.

15 minute parking in any loading area.

No swimming in any pond on the property.

Trespassing on Land O' Lakes/Longview Animal Nutrition Center property is forbidden. No one is permitted anywhere that is marked "**Employees Only**" and/or "**No Admittance**". These are separate divisions of Purina and are not part of the show grounds.

No selling of puppies or dogs on the premises.

All dogs are required to be on leash at all times, except when crated or as required to be judged.

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety.

Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

The ABdFC is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.

The American Bouvier des Flandres Club of America, Inc. reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal. We will attempt to reach the responsible party but cannot guarantee contact will be made before action is taken.
